➡ The **School of Public Health web site:**

➡ **Orientation program:**

During Orientation week (24th and 25th July) we'll be running a series of 'technical' training sessions to help you come to grips with using the School's IT facilities, learning online, using the library and conducting literature searches, as well as a Welcome for new students. During those days you'll also be able to pick up the notes for your technical sessions and your orientation manual – all useful documents to get you started.

➡ **What you need to do:**

- Register for the technical sessions. Numbers for each session are limited so you'll need to register in advance. Go to <http://www.health.usyd.edu.au/news/events/orientation/index.php> and complete the online form. You'll receive an email confirmation of your registration.
- On the 24th and 25th July from 9.00am to 5.00pm come to the LTSU room 329, to meet us, have your photo taken and collect your orientation and course documents.
- Attend the Orientation and Welcome sessions for your course - http://www.health.usyd.edu.au/news/events/orientation/08_midyear_program_v2-1.pdf. These sessions are designed to introduce you to the world of public health in general, some important School of Public health policies and then the specific details of the course you are enrolled in. No need to register.

➡ **Keeping track** of your enrolment, results and other admin:

Go to My Uni <http://myuni.usyd.edu.au/> You'll need to be enrolled and have a UniKey to do this. Your UniKey is your login to a range of University services; its format is ABCD1234 and it's printed on your enrolment documentation.

➡ **Getting online**

Each unit of study in the school has a course web site, which usually becomes available about a week before the unit starts. There are also two free support sites for you to use if you wish. You need to be enrolled to access them. Go to www.usyd.edu.au, click on Current Students then on Login: USyd eLearning.
